An outdoor wood-burning fireplace, a nest in which to seek refuge, enjoying the warmth of the fire: the eccentric dance of the flame slowly becomes the silent glow of embers. A sweet warmth that comforts your guests.

Zero is a wood-burning outdoor fire pit designed for special outdoor moments. Design and art blend to present the fire with a contemporary style. An outdoor fireplace, simple in its shape with a generous and strong character.

Not only a fire pit, but also a wood storage: if not operating, it can become a useful supporting surface.

Zero is supplied with a steel cover plate to cover the combustion chamber. Accessories sold separately: Stainless steel barbecue grill, Fire screen, Storage cover. Product supplied in an assembly kit.

The fire pit may display superficial irregularity and chromatic variations, due to the choice to use materials and finishes able to enhance the natural process of aging, thus giving guarantee of uniqueness.

The Corten steel is supplied in its natural state (blue/black). The surface has not yet developed the typical protective patina, this patina only develops under natural weathering conditions.

The duration of the oxidation process will then depend on exposure to atmospheric agents. During the first stage of the maturation process, the corten natural steel may leak oxide, which may stain surfaces where products are located: this shall be considered natural and physiological behavior of the material. At the end of the natural cycle of maturation, the corten steel reaches the characteristic dark brown shade.

Possible movements, cracks and other wood changes due to natural adjustment and different environmental conditions are an intrinsic feature of this material. This characteristic is due to the quality of the material used, not a defect.

When exposed to the weather, the surface of Chestnut wood oxidises, giving it a characteristic silver-grey colour and its typical "aged" look.

Care & Maintenance, always recommended:
Keep your fire pit clean.

For normal cleaning of the surfaces, use a soft cloth and lukewarm water, do not use abrasive substances, solvents or degreaser products.




To slow down the natural oxidation process of the wooden top, it's suggested the periodic application of a nourishing protective oil to the surface.

All products are guaranteed against manufacturing defects over a period of 24 months from purchase date. Breakages, defects caused by improper use and buyer negligence are excluded of the warranty, as well as damages caused by normal wear and tear or bad assembly of the products. Defects due to normal aging and color changes deriving from exposure to atmospheric agents are also excluded of the warranty.




